Current Campus Planning Committee (CPC) Charge

- Members act on what is in the best interest of the institution as a whole.




- New Universities of Wisconsin (UoW) Submission Process

 - > Fall 2025 Completion of Campus Strategic Plan & Campus Framework Plan begins
 - > FP&M works with exec leadership to craft a Framework Plan and determine project priorities that is reflective of Strategic Plan
 - > Framework Plan and Project Priorities are reviewed by Campus Planning Committee and others.
